Congratulations on the opening of the 2022 ANBD regular exhibition.

Despite the difficult conditions of the COVID-19 pandemic, which has continued for three years around the world, we are glad that ANBD can hold the exhibition without stopping. In addition, despite the worst conditions, I would like to express my infinite gratitude to the artists of each region who submitted and the representatives of each region for their dedicated cooperation in holding the exhibition.

The ANBD started its first exhibition in Seoul, Tokyo, Tianjin and Taipei in 2008 and expanded to 10 Asian regions (Seoul, Tokyo, Tianjin, Taipei, Kuala Lumpur, Bangkok, Shanxi, Colombo, Tainan, and Shanghai) until this year, holding a total of 60 regular exhibitions.

Apart from the regular exhibition, we also held six special exhibitions, starting with Japan's Sapporo Special Exhibition, Munich in Germany, Colombo in Sri Lanka, Jeju Island in Korea, and this year's Phuket Special Exhibition.

The theme of the 2022 ANBD exhibition is Journey. The pandemic caused by Covid-19 has brought about not only different behaviors and habits but also changes in the social environment. But the changes that we find in our lives and social environments are not limited to pandemics. There's an idea in the East that change is a normal state. The world is always changing. We are always on the path of change, and the subject of the ANBD exhibition so far has been a valuable milestone. Through this theme, ANBD 2022 expects creations that express a journey to a new dimension in a broad sense triggered by culture, life change, sustainability of the social environment, and further creation and transformation.

This year, 228 artists from 7 regions submitted 912 creations(97 in Seoul, 48 in Bangkok, 33 in Tokyo, 18 in Taipei, 17 in Tainan, 13 in Kuala Lumpur, and 2 in Colombo).

Through exhibition activities, designers, painters, sculptors, photographers, and cultural planners who are active in design fields in Asia as well as art and culture are participating, and they are striving to create new values beyond the boundaries of all arts and various designs.

Finally, I would like to thank the exhibitors and representatives of each region once again for their hard work.


