I am Cho Youl, the chairman of ANBD.

First of all, congratulations on the opening of the 2024 ANBD Singapore Special exhibition. The ANBD special exhibition started in 2017 and has been celebrated for eight consecutive years. Asian Network Beyond Design (ANBD) is expanding its cultural value by converging the characteristics of each region 16 years ago. We look forward to continuing active creative activities and exchanges with Singapore, which held a new special exhibition this time.

This year's theme for the 2024 ANBD regular exhibition is "No Boundary." This theme reflects how the pandemic has introduced a new environment, where social interactions have expanded beyond the virtual world to form new relationships. As boundaries between regions and countries become less relevant, the art domain has evolved to be more inclusive and creative, interpreted through a broader perspective.

ANBD 2024 expects artworks that can lead to true communication by understanding each other's culture and art through true "No Boundary"

ANBD started its first exhibition in 4 Asian regions in 2008 (Seoul, Tokyo, Tianjin, and Taipei), and has been held in 12 Asia and Europe regions (Korea, Japan, Taiwan, China, Malaysia, Thailand, Sri Lanka, France, Egypt, Italy, Polandand, USA) by this year. A total of 64 regular exhibitions were held over 16 years.

In addition to the regular exhibition, a total of 7 special exhibitions were held, starting with the Sapporo special exhibition in Japan, Munich in Germany, Colombo in Sri Lanka, Jeju in Korea, Phuket in Thailand, Kyushu in Japan and Singapore, Internet virtual space exhibition.

This year, 236 artists from 12 regions submitted 944 artworks (Seoul 99, Bangkok 44, Tokyo 30, Taipei 21, Tainan 17, Kuala Lumpur 12, Colombo 4, France I, Egypt I, Italy I, USA I, Qingdao I, including 5 headquarter).

Finally, once again, I would like to express my infinite gratitude to the participating artists and the regional representatives for their hard work. I think ANBD is growing every year with the sincerity of you who work hard for the future and development of ANBD every year. If you express your sincere gratitude, I look forward to meeting you at the main exhibition in Bangkok, the last exhibition of this year.


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2024 ANBD Examination Review
